#### Position & Responsibilities

## Role Summary

Collaborating with staff to support people of all genders who have experienced relationship violence, sexual assault, exploitation, stalking and/or harassment, our Adult and Family Advocates are responsible for providing individualized supportive services and comprehensive advocacy to individuals and families currently living at Tubman's shelters.

- Foster a safe and empowering community and practice advocacy to support individuals and families who have experienced trauma or violence
- Gain experience in a residential shelter setting, facilitating one-on-one client interactions and recording strengths-based case notes

- Follow agency guidelines interacting with clients to identify their needs and goals
- Co-facilitate groups that encourage healthy relationships, peaceful community living, and goal attainment
- Answer crisis and resource phone line and assist clients as needed

## **Position Qualifications:**

- Experience providing direct service/resources to clients
- Comfortable working under pressure, able to remain calm in response to crisis situations
- Excellent communication skills, including active listening skills and ability to respond without judgment to client needs, reacting appropriately with empathy and respect
- Demonstrated ability to maintain appropriate professional boundaries and confidentiality
- Be comfortable with the computer this position involves using basic computer programs, internet research, and multiline phone systems
- Ability to work with diverse teams and clients to foster a culturally inclusive environment

• Commit to 10-12 hours per week for a minimum of four months (or 15 hours per week for a summer placement)

- Attend Tubman's five part Volunteer/Intern Orientation and Training series
- Supervision provided by Adult and Family Advocate staff within Tubman's shelters
